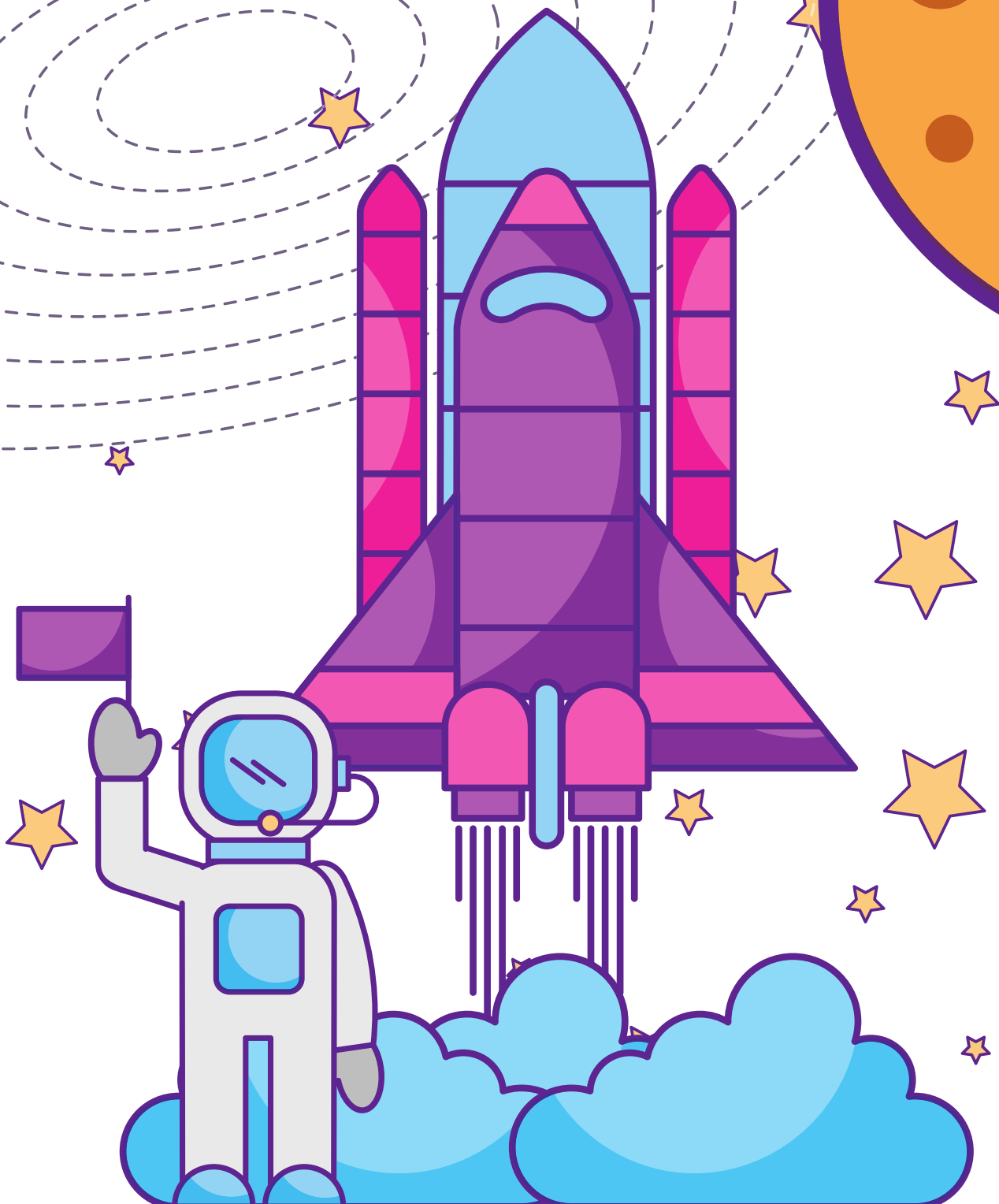
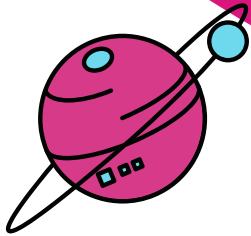

Supplies:

Crayons

White cardstock

Paintbrush

Black water color OR
watered down paint

Paper towels



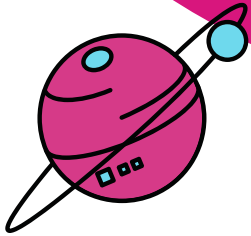
Start by coloring a space scene on the cardstock. Stars, planets, shooting stars, rockets, aliens, etc. Color them in completely with the crayons.

Brush over the whole paper with the black water color. The waxy crayon won't absorb the paint and it beads up a little.

Pat with a paper towel to clean off paint that beads up on the crayon.

Let dry, and display your beautiful space picture.

VANILLA STAR BISCUITS

Ingredients:

150g Butter (unsalted)

75g Caster Sugar

2 tsp Vanilla Extract

300g Plain white flour

1 Egg

150g White chocolate

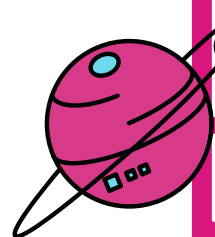
Preheat the oven to 180°C (160°C fan). Line 2 baking trays with non-stick baking paper.

Cream the butter, sugar and vanilla extract together in a mixing bowl until creamy. Add the egg and continue to mix, gradually adding the flour until you reach a soft dough. Wrap in clingfilm and chill for 30 minutes.

Roll out the dough 5mm/1/4" thick on a surface dusted with a little flour. Cut out 40 stars. Place on the baking trays and bake for about 15 minutes until golden brown.

Remove and cool on a wire rack.

To decorate, melt the white chocolate and drizzle over the top of the stars. Leave to set.



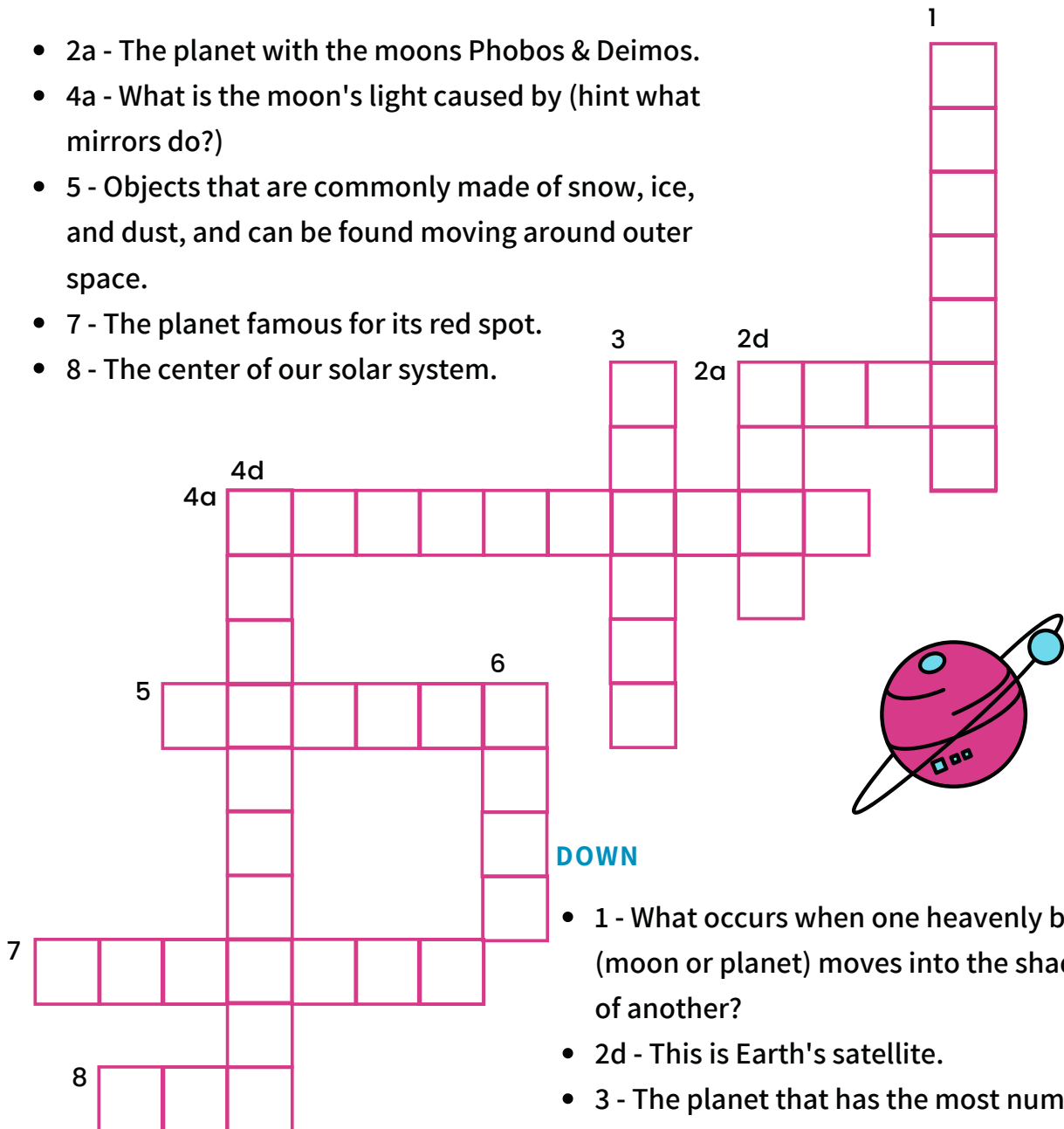
